

# HORSE CAMPS



The Camp Roger horse programs are designed to provide participants a full camp experience. Campers will spend half of each day in the arena or on the trail, the other half of each day the campers will participate in traditional camp activities.

## **Junior Wrangler Camp** (Ages 8-9)

Campers will learn the basics of safety around horses, grooming, tacking, leading, tying, and general horse care. This is a great program to get campers started learning about horses and feeling comfortable in a camp environment!

## **Junior Ranch Camp** (Ages 8-9)

This program is designed to enhance the knowledge of Junior Wranglers. These campers will begin to learn more in-depth information of horse care, saddling, and riding.

*Requirements: Participants must have completed Camp Roger's junior wrangler camp.*

## **Wrangler Camp** (Ages 10-14)

For those who want a sampling of horsemanship skills, Camp Roger Wranglers will spend time in the arena and on the trail learning to work with a horse. Safety guidelines, grooming, saddling, proper riding techniques and controlling a horse will be among the topics covered.

## **Rodeo Camp** (Ages 10-14)

Under the close supervision of our skilled equestrian staff, Rodeo campers will spend each morning at the Camp Roger Ranch working in the arena and

on the trail learning more about the different gaits of a horse, practicing their roping skills, and sample barrel and flag racing.

*Requirements: Rodeo Campers must have participated in Camp Roger's wrangler camp or provide proof of equivalent experience.*

## **Ranch Camp** (Ages 10-14)

Through their work at the Camp Roger Ranch in the arena and on the trail, Ranch Campers, under the close supervision of our skilled equestrian staff, will learn more about horse care, and advanced techniques for controlling, riding and exercising a horse that they have been assigned for the week.

*Requirements: Ranch campers must have participated in Camp Roger's wrangler camp or provide proof of equivalent experience.*

## **Ranch Management** (Ages 12-14)

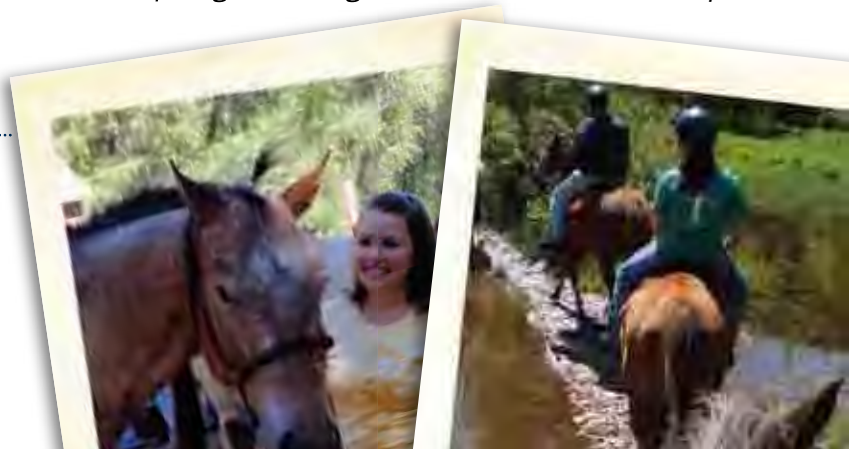
This program is designed for older campers who own a horse, or hope to own one. Through their work at the ranch and on horseback, campers will learn the skills and responsibilities needed to care for and manage horses. Lessons will include health and anatomy, environmental considerations, and behavior.

*Requirements: Ranch campers must have participated in Camp Roger's wrangler and ranch camps.*

## **Horse Explorer** (Ages 13-15)

This program is designed for older campers who have had more experience working with horses. This week will be a real "western" experience in the Uintas. Campers will go on long trail rides, learn to pack up the horses and prepare for the trail and enjoy pack out lunches amongst the beautiful scenery.

*Requirements: Campers must have participated in Camp Roger's wrangler and ranch or rodeo camps.*
