

LEADERSHIP CAMPS

Leaders-in-Training (L.I.T.) *(Ages 15-16)*

L.I.T. is a two week specialized staff-training program which, along with the C.I.T. program, trains campers in necessary skills and responsibilities to be staff in years to come. LIT's participate in leadership development focusing on team building, cooperation, and supervision. They will work side-by-side with staff members to gain skills in managing group behavior, leading activities, and supporting the staff.

Wranglers-in-Training (W.I.T.) *(Ages 15-16)*

W.I.T. is a two week specialized staff-training program which, along with the C.I.T. program, trains campers to become staff in years to come. W.I.T.'s participate in leadership development focusing on team building, cooperation, and supervision. W.I.T.'s assist wranglers with trail rides and arena lessons along with assisting in care, feeding, grooming, cleaning, and early morning chores. W.I.T. applicants must have completed the Wrangler riding level at Camp Roger.

Counselor-in-Training *(Ages 16-17)*

The CIT experience will build upon and refine participant's leadership abilities through more work in programs and cabins. CIT's will help plan, prepare and lead camp activities, exploring camp operations and assist with cabin groups. Their final week at camp C.I.T.'s will assist Counselors in the cabin. This is a great Leadership Development opportunity that is transferable to almost any future experience, including college applications.
